City of Mount Vernon Downtown Revitalization (PY 2014)

The City of Mount Vernon will partner with the Heritage Centre Association to undertake a comprehensive downtown revitalization program in the City's Central Business District. The City will assist 15 building/business owners in the target area with private rehabilitation projects, including façade improvements and code violation corrections. The City will also install sidewalks, curbs and curb cuts on W. High and N. Main Streets and Public Square, and make improvements to the W. High and Sandusky Streets intersection. The project will benefit 14,080 individuals.
